## **NP Aerospace commits:**

- 1) To comply with, applicable environmental legislation, regulatory controls and codes of practice and other requirements to which the company subscribes
- 2) To reduce and, where practicable, prevent avoidable pollution and nuisance that may be caused by our activities and minimise the risk of pollution to air, land and water.
- 3) To reduce the consumption of natural resources such as fossil fuels, water and energy and to minimise material wastage through the implementation of resource efficiency measures and waste management programmes.
- 4) To invest in the development of new products and processes that has an improved performance regarding their impact on the environment.
- 5) To ensure that all employees are made aware and accountable for these policy goals through training and communication of environmental issues throughout the company.
- 6) To introduce and operate a formal Environmental Management System designed to meet the requirements of BS EN ISO 14001:2004.
- 7) To encourage all employees to be proactive in the maintenance and further development of the Environmental Management System.
- 8) To encourage our suppliers and sub-contractors to adopt environmentally sensitive systems.
- 9) To set annually environmental objectives and targets which shall be followed up to ensure continual improvement in the environmental performance of the company.
- 10) To review and update the Environmental policy at regular intervals.
